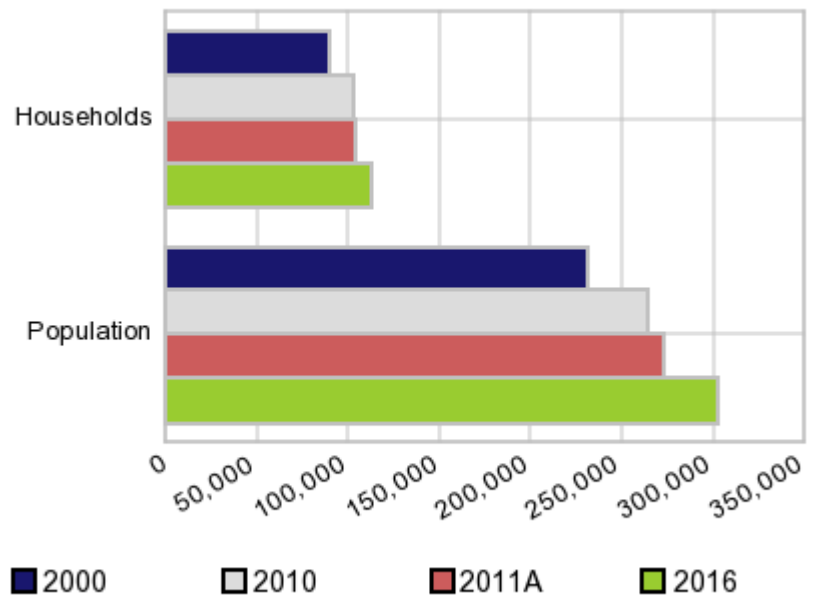
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **89,865** and changed to **103,038** in 2010, representing a change of **14.7%**. The household count in 2011A was **105,103** and the household projection for 2016 is **113,337**, a change of **7.8%**.

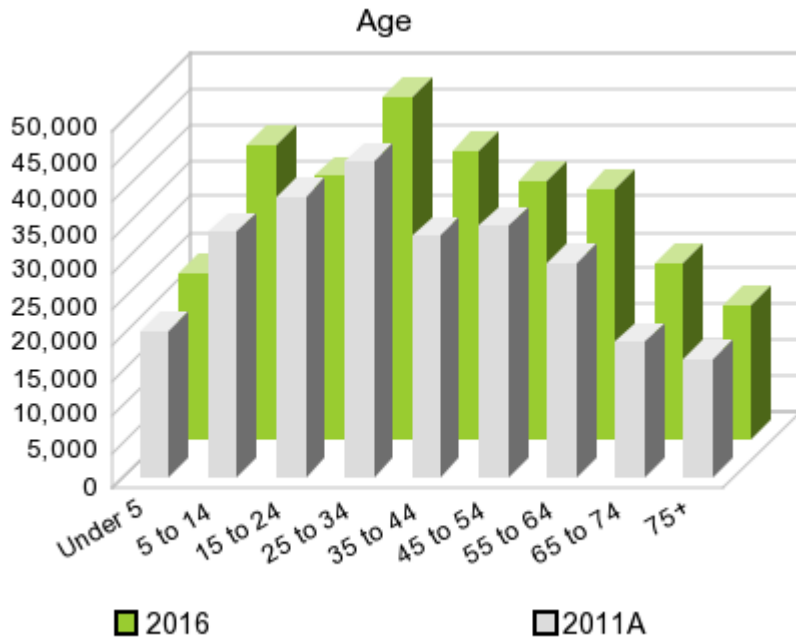
The population in the study area in 2000 was **232,048** and in 2010 it was **265,128**, roughly a **14.3%** change. The population in 2011A was **272,773** and the projection for 2016 is **302,834** representing a change of **11.0%**.

Population by Age



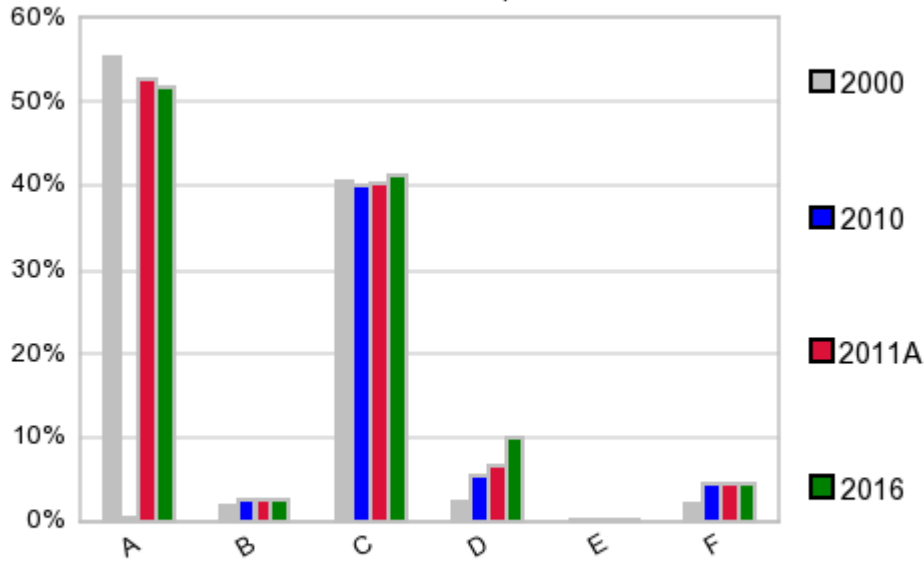
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32**, and in 2000, it was **34**. The median age in 2011A is **34** and it is predicted to change in five years to **36** years. In 2011A, females represented **52.3%** of the population with a median age of **36** and males represented **47.8%** of the population with a median age of **33** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 25 to 34** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

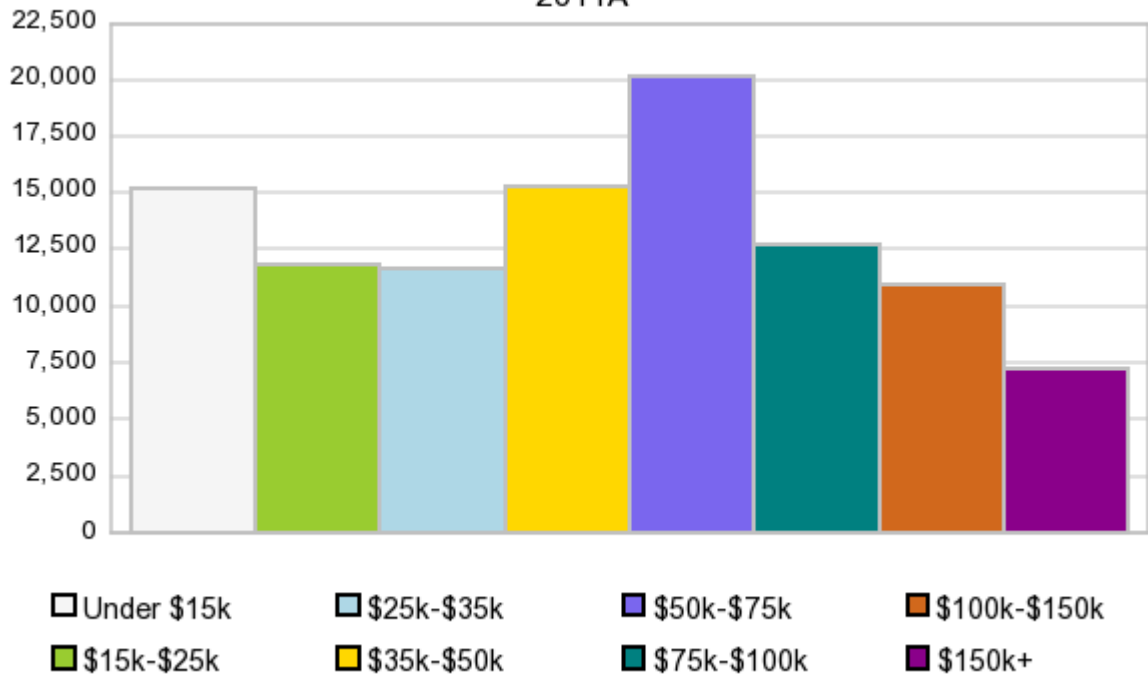
