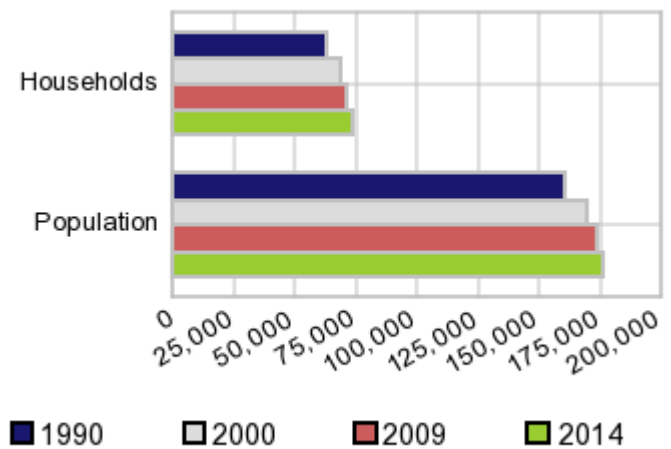
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **63,771** and changed to **68,920** in 2000, representing a change of **8.1%**. The household count in 2009 was **71,719** and the household projection for 2014 is **73,470**, a change of **2.4%**.

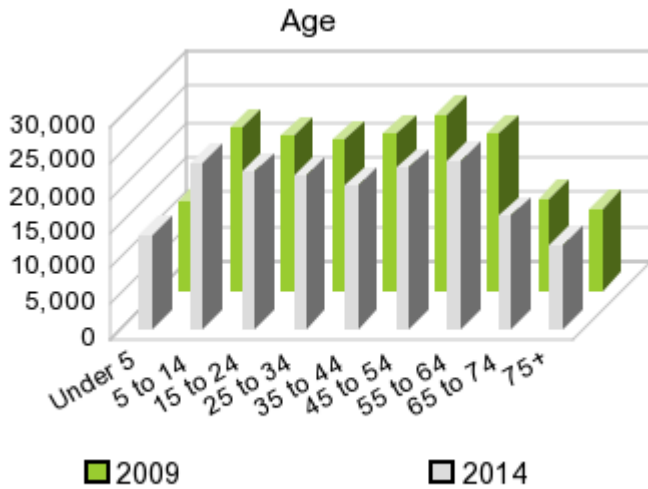
The population in the study area in 1990 was **160,979** and in 2000 it was **169,871**, roughly a **5.5%** change. The population in 2009 was **174,156** and the projection for 2014 is **176,528** representing a change of **1.4%**.

Population by Age

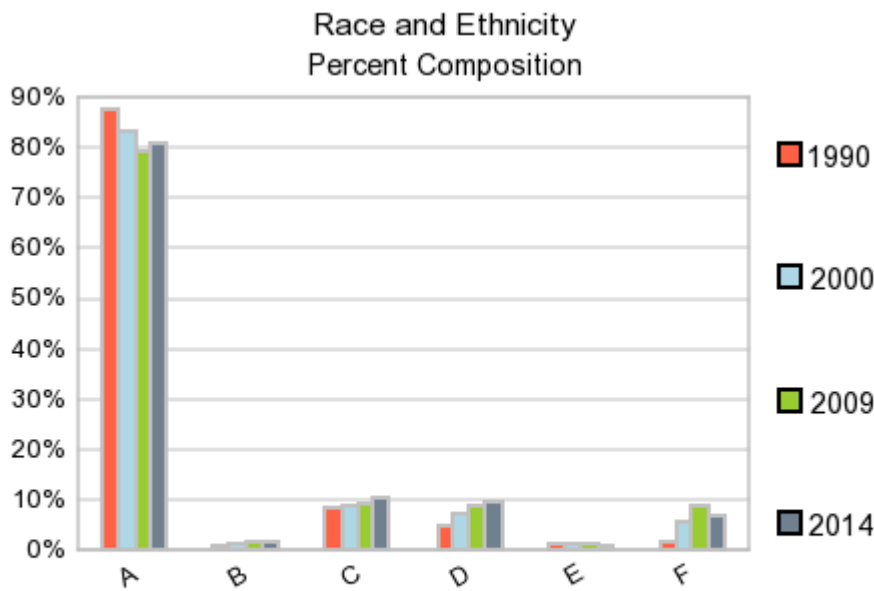


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33.8**, and in 2000, it was **37.1**. The median age in 2009 is **38.6** and it is predicted to change in five years to **38.6** years. In 2009, females represented **53.2%** of the population with a median age of **39.5** and males represented **46.8%** of the population with a median age of **37.3** years. In 2009, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.

- F: Other or Multi Race

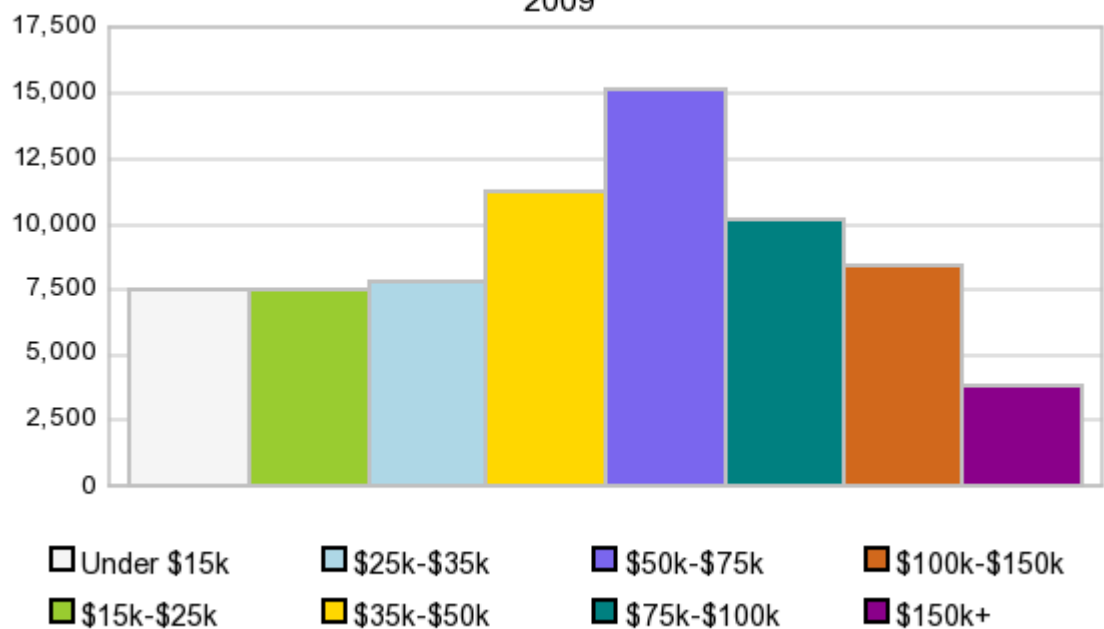
