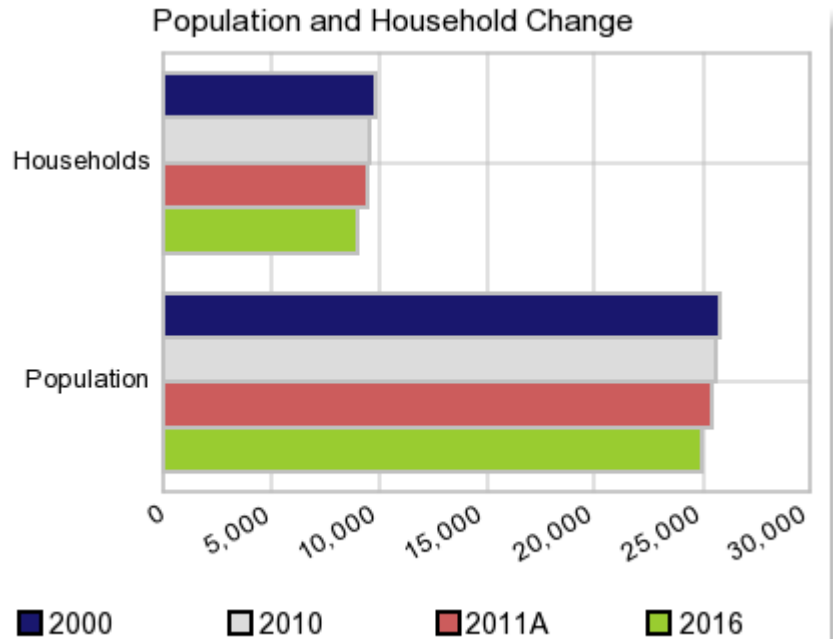

### Population Demographics:

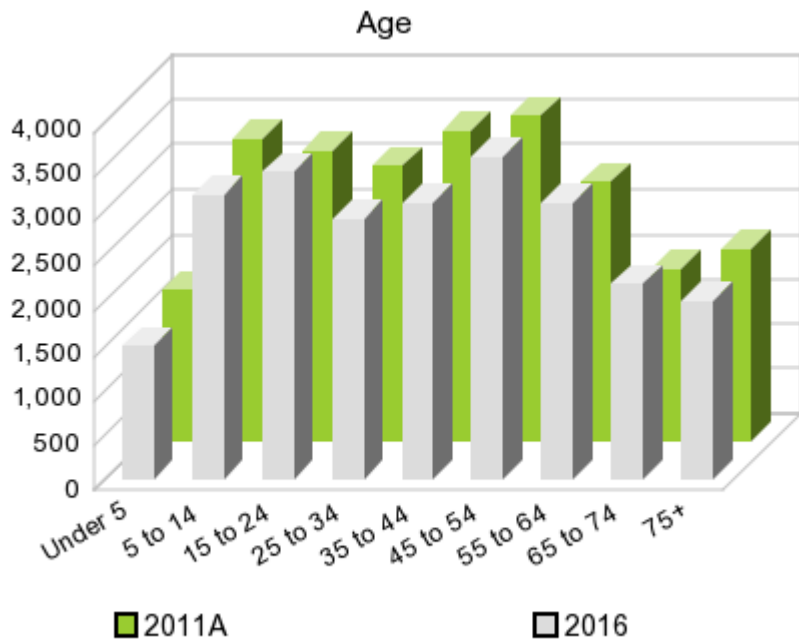
The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **9,844** and changed to **9,590** in 2010, representing a change of **-2.6%**. The household count in 2011A was **9,485** and the household projection for 2016 is **9,077**, a change of **-4.3%**.

The population in the study area in 2000 was **25,853** and in 2010 it was **25,529**, roughly a **-1.3%** change. The population in 2011A was **25,421** and the projection for 2016 is **24,969** representing a change of **-1.8%**.

### Population by Age



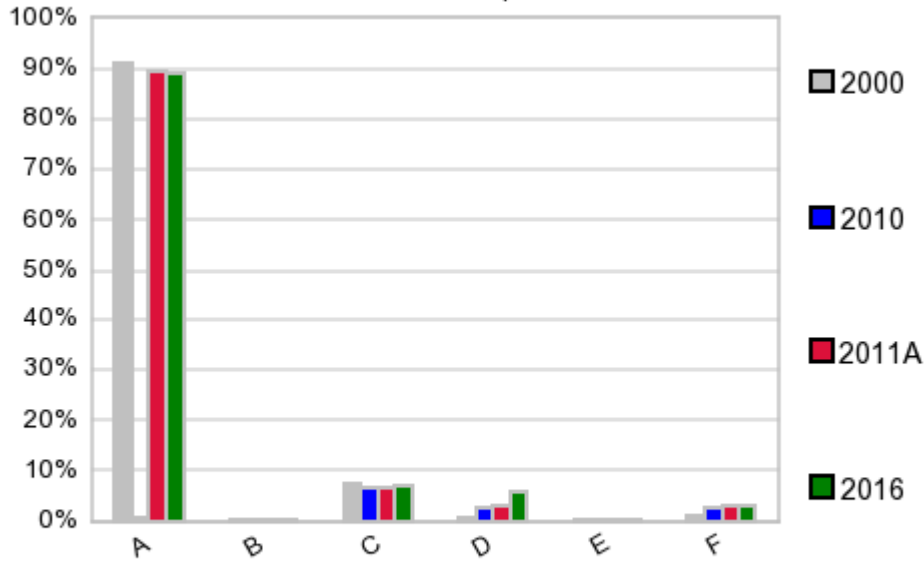
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **37**, and in 2000, it was **38**. The median age in 2011A is **39** and it is predicted to change in five years to **40** years. In 2011A, females represented **55.0%** of the population with a median age of **40** and males represented **45.0%** of the population with a median age of **38** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.

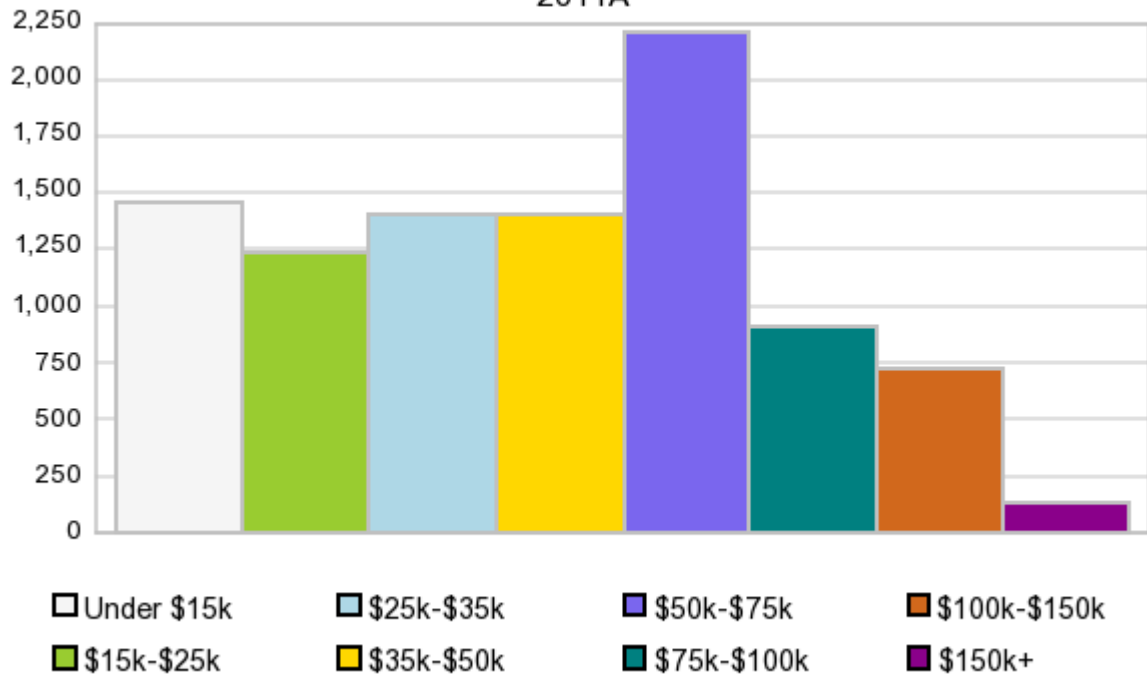
