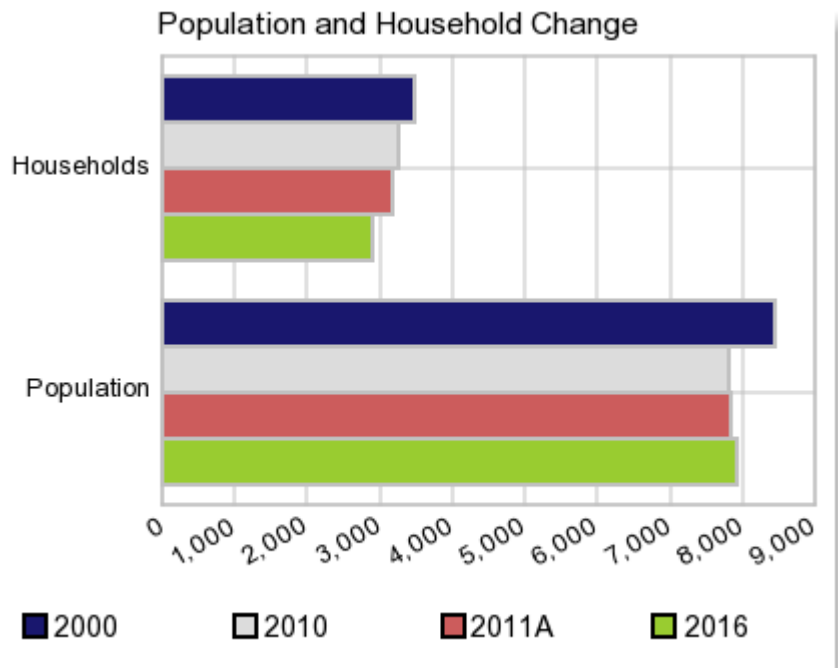

## Executive Summary Report with Charts

### Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **3,469** and changed to **3,242** in 2010, representing a change of **-6.5%**. The household count in 2011A was **3,170** and the household projection for 2016 is **2,897**, a change of **-8.6%**.

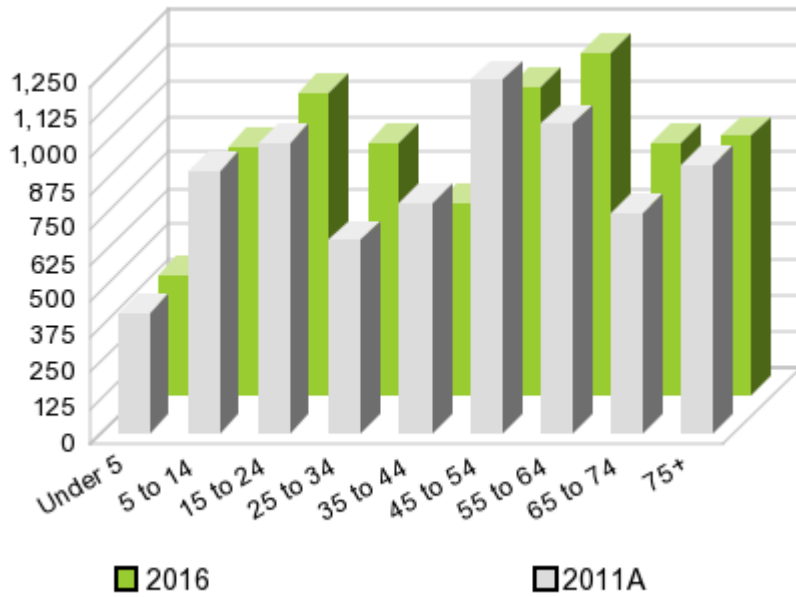
The population in the study area in 2000 was **8,438** and in 2010 it was **7,831**, roughly a **-7.2%** change. The population in 2011A was **7,854** and the projection for 2016 is **7,935** representing a change of **1.0%**.

### Age



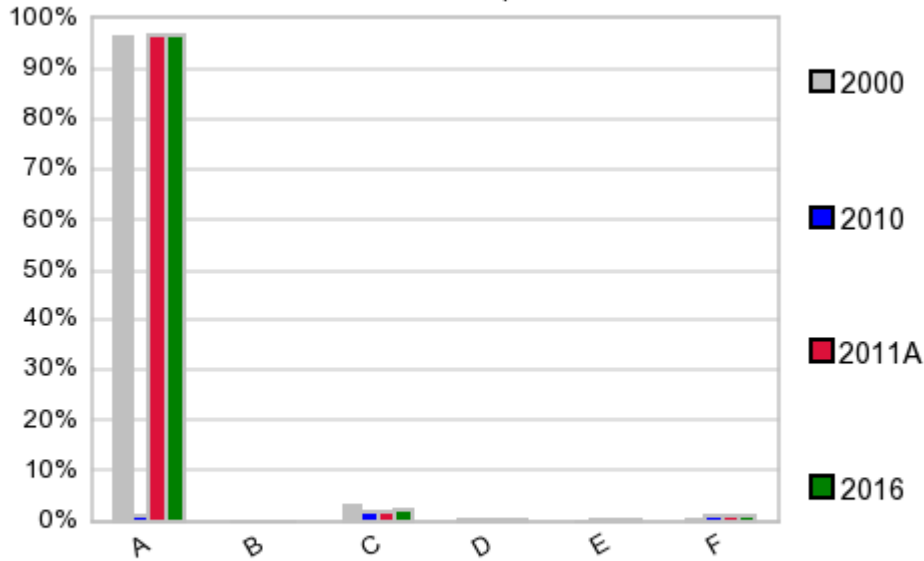
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **39**, and in 2000, it was **43**. The median age in 2011A is **46** and it is predicted to change in five years to **46** years. In 2011A, females represented **51.7%** of the population with a median age of **47** and males represented **48.3%** of the population with a median age of **45** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **Asian or Pacific Islander**.

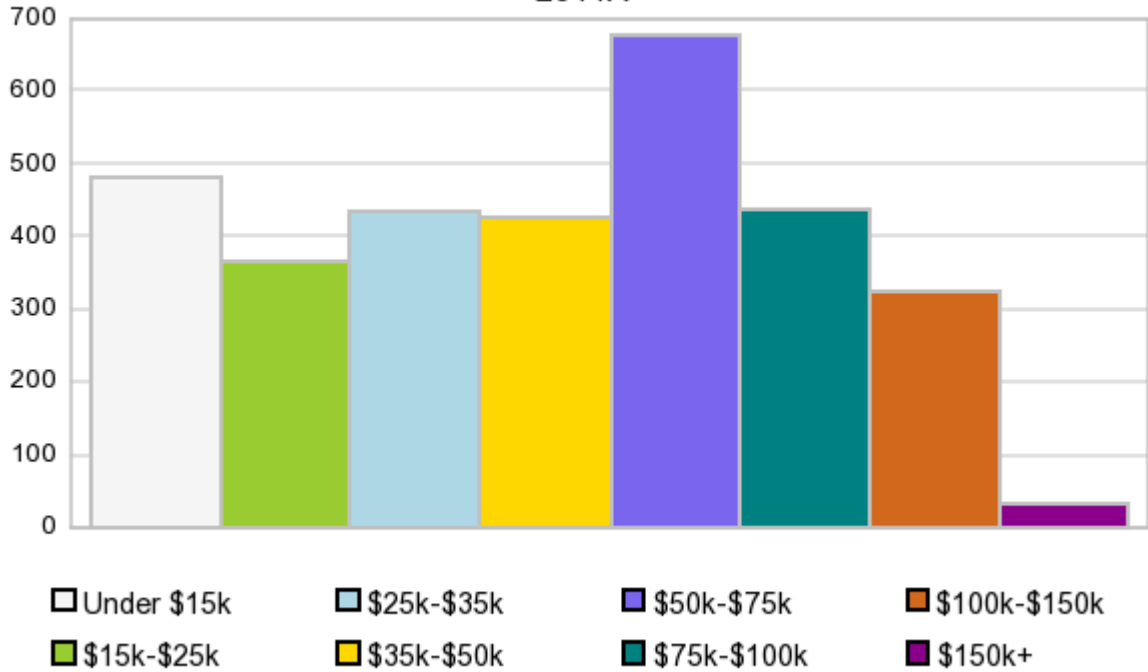
