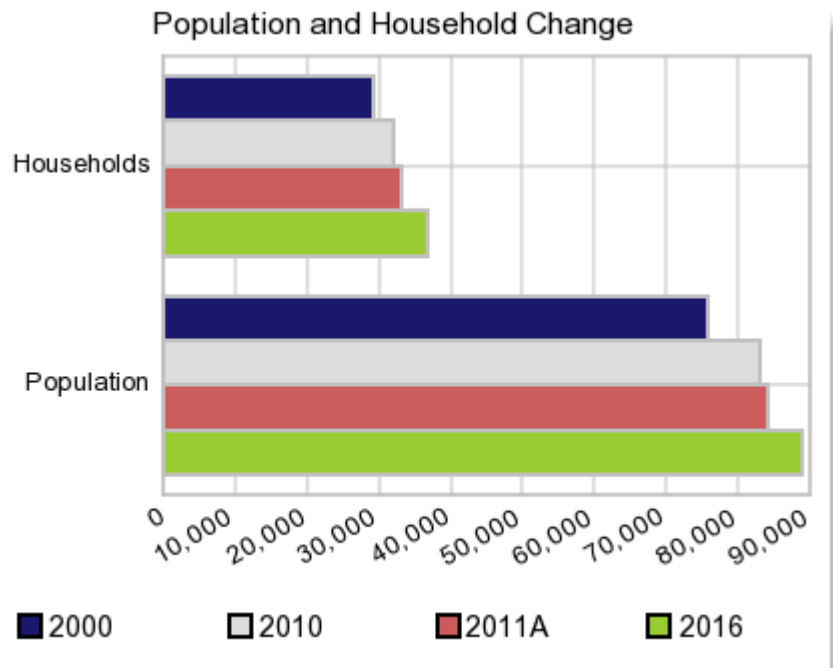

Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **29,200** and changed to **32,086** in 2010, representing a change of **9.9%**. The household count in 2011A was **33,012** and the household projection for 2016 is **36,621**, a change of **10.9%**.

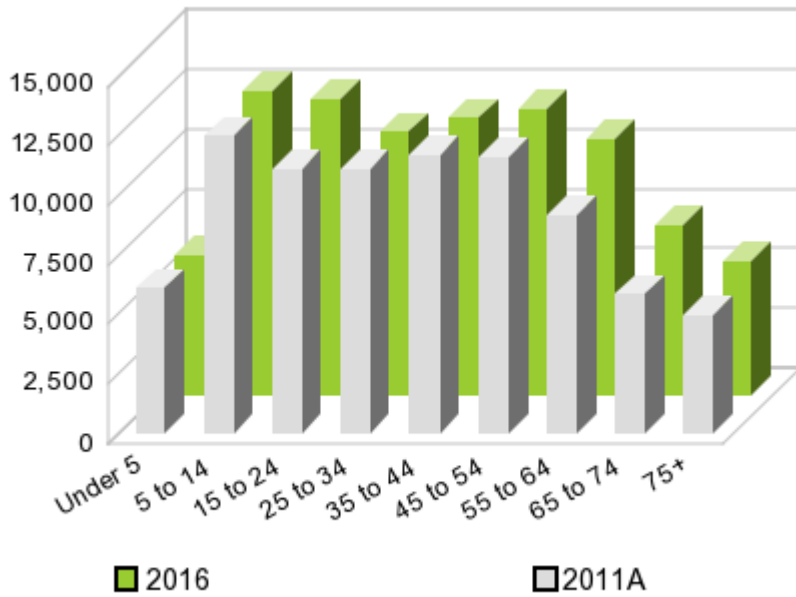
The population in the study area in 2000 was **75,755** and in 2010 it was **82,910**, roughly a **9.4%** change. The population in 2011A was **84,159** and the projection for 2016 is **89,023** representing a change of **5.8%**.

Age



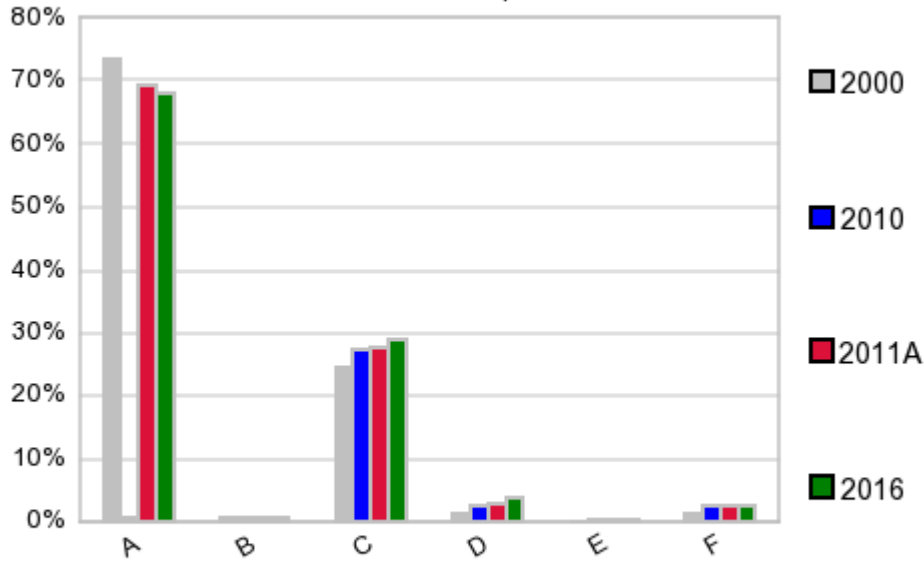
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32**, and in 2000, it was **35**. The median age in 2011A is **36** and it is predicted to change in five years to **37** years. In 2011A, females represented **52.0%** of the population with a median age of **38** and males represented **48.0%** of the population with a median age of **35** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 5 to 14** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

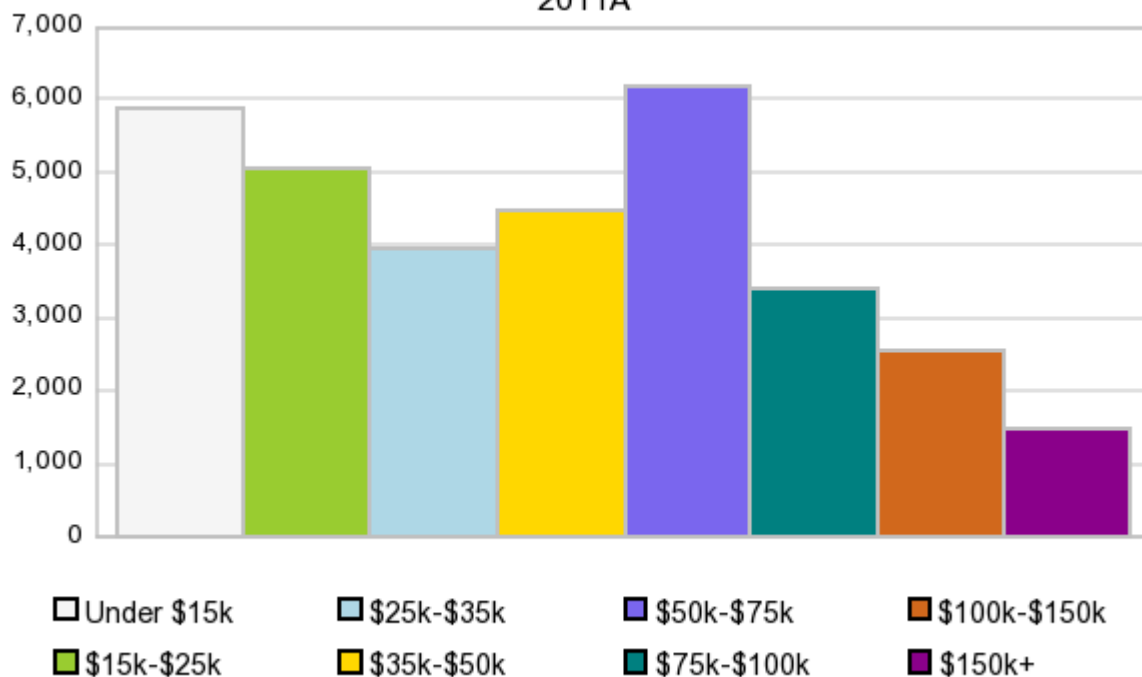
