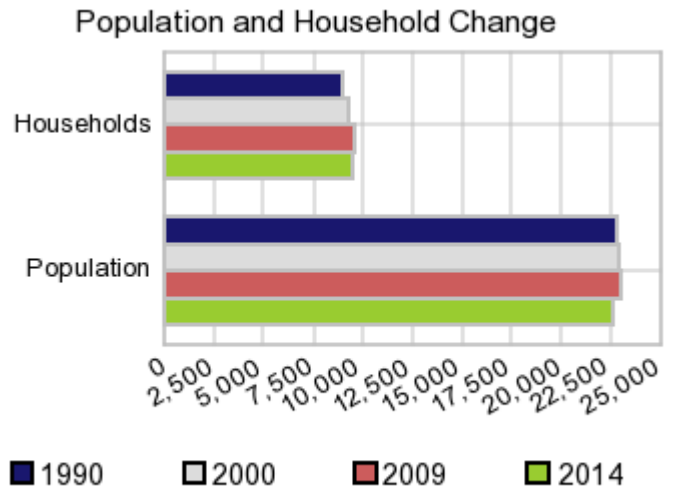

### Population Demographics

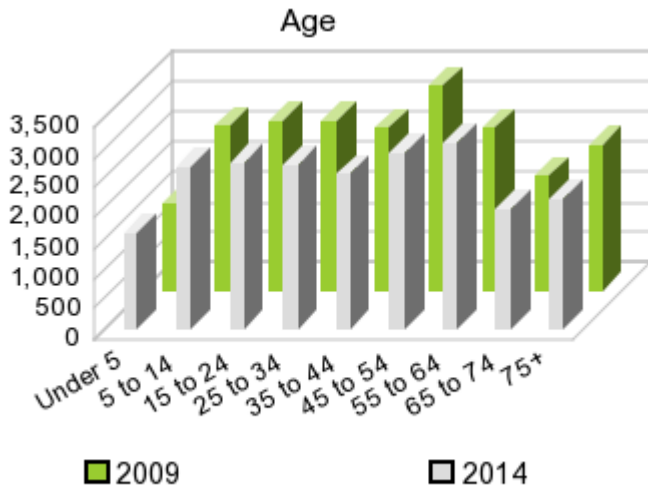
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **9,019** and changed to **9,316** in 2000, representing a change of **3.3%**. The household count in 2009 was **9,562** and the household projection for 2014 is **9,438**, a change of **-1.3%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **22,794** and in 2000 it was **22,993**, roughly a **0.9%** change. The population in 2009 was **23,017** and the projection for 2014 is **22,601** representing a change of **-1.8%**.

### Population by Age

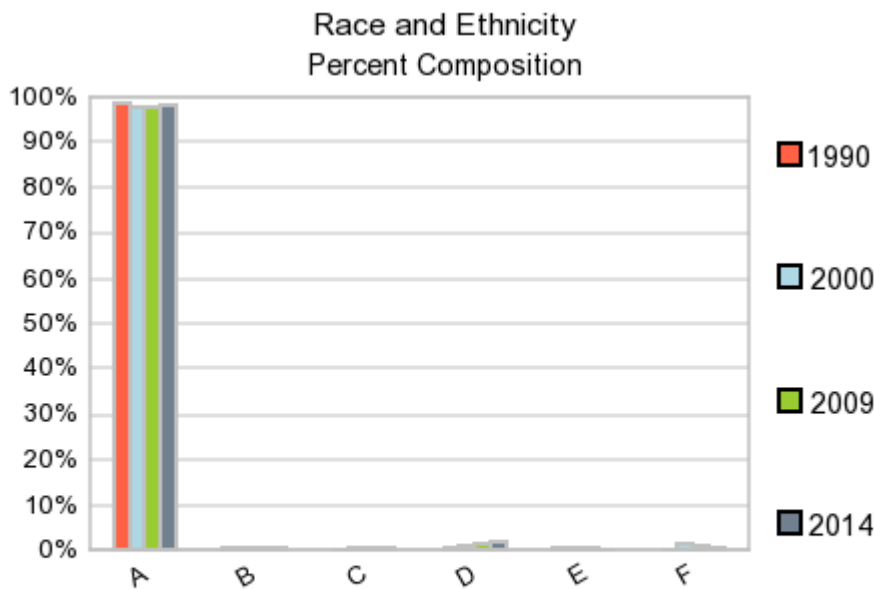


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **37.2**, and in 2000, it was **39.9**. The median age in 2009 is **41.3** and it is predicted to change in five years to **40.6** years. In 2009, females represented **50.9%** of the population with a median age of **43.0** and males represented **49.1%** of the population with a median age of **39.7** years. In 2009, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.

- F: Other or Multi Race

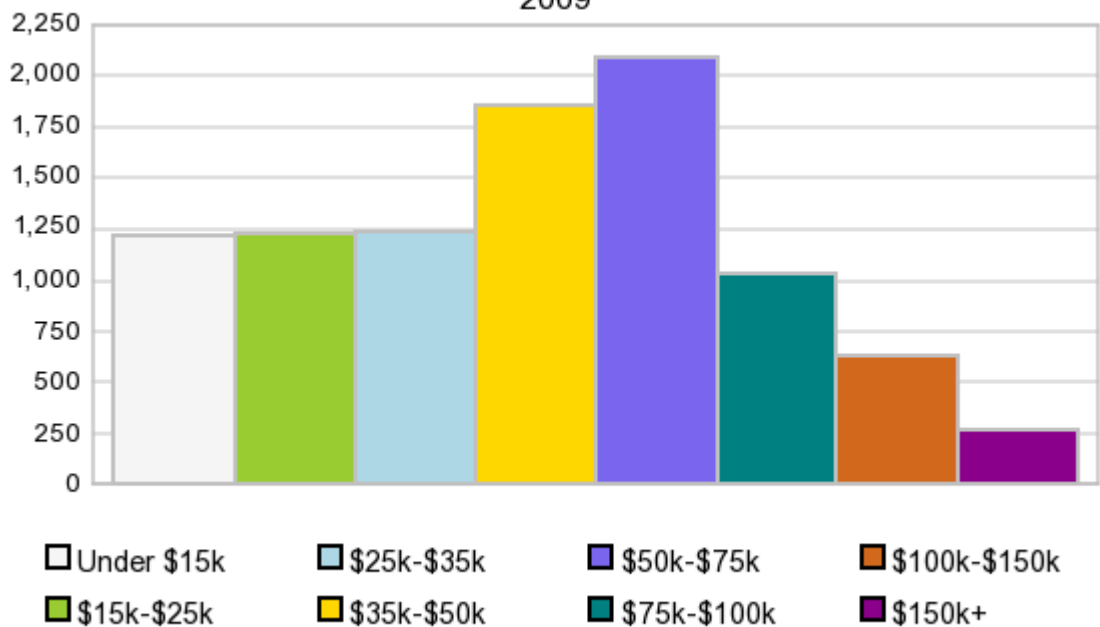
