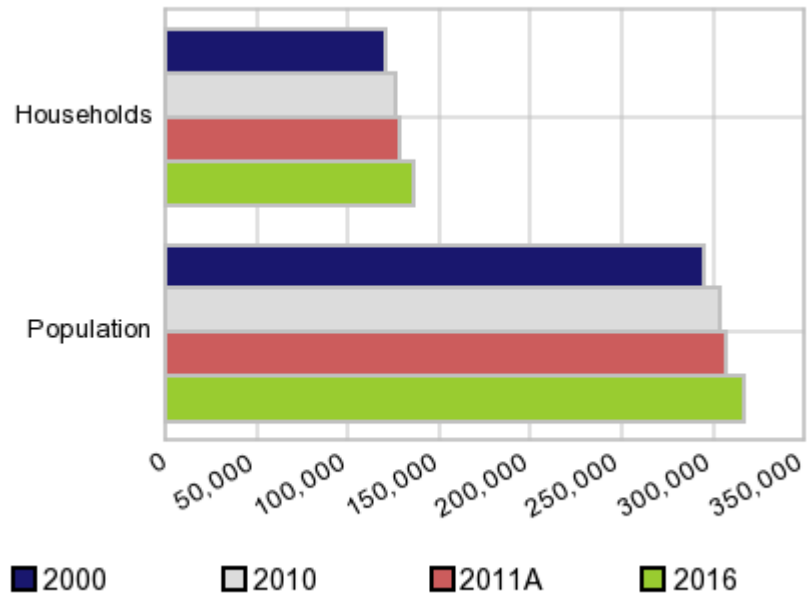
## Executive Summary Report with Charts

### Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **120,512** and changed to **126,251** in 2010, representing a change of **4.8%**. The household count in 2011A was **128,031** and the household projection for 2016 is **135,149**, a change of **5.6%**.

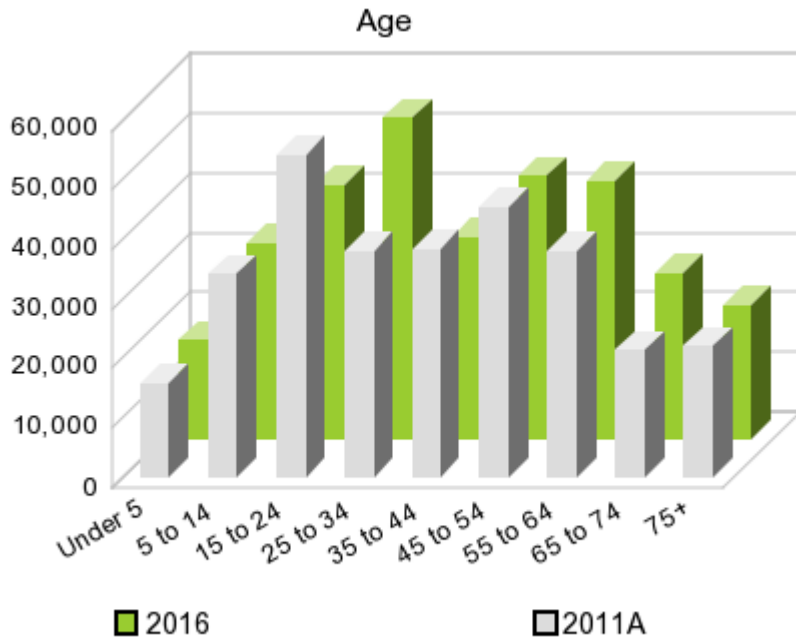
The population in the study area in 2000 was **294,565** and in 2010 it was **304,204**, roughly a **3.3%** change. The population in 2011A was **306,866** and the projection for 2016 is **317,361** representing a change of **3.4%**.

### Population by Age



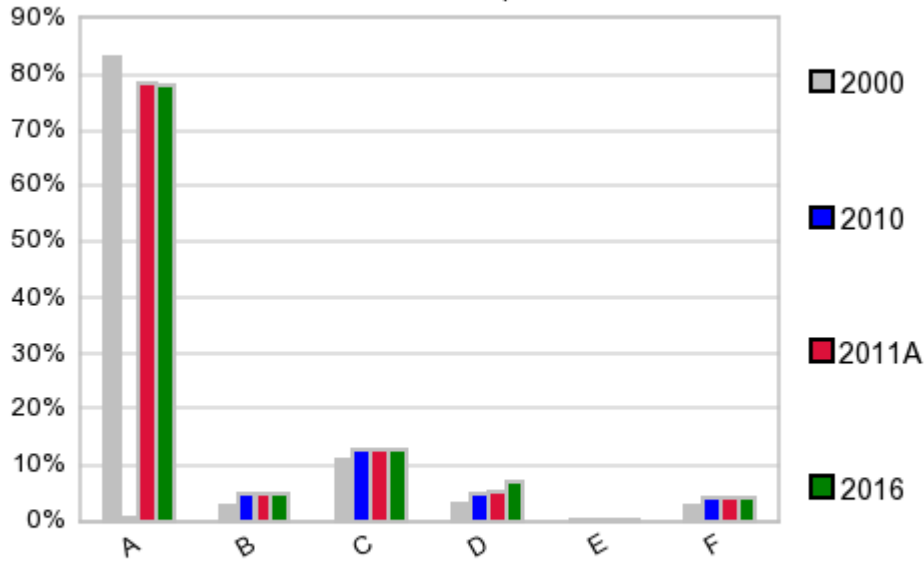
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **34**, and in 2000, it was **37**. The median age in 2011A is **38** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39** years. In 2011A, females represented **51.9%** of the population with a median age of **40** and males represented **48.1%** of the population with a median age of **37** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

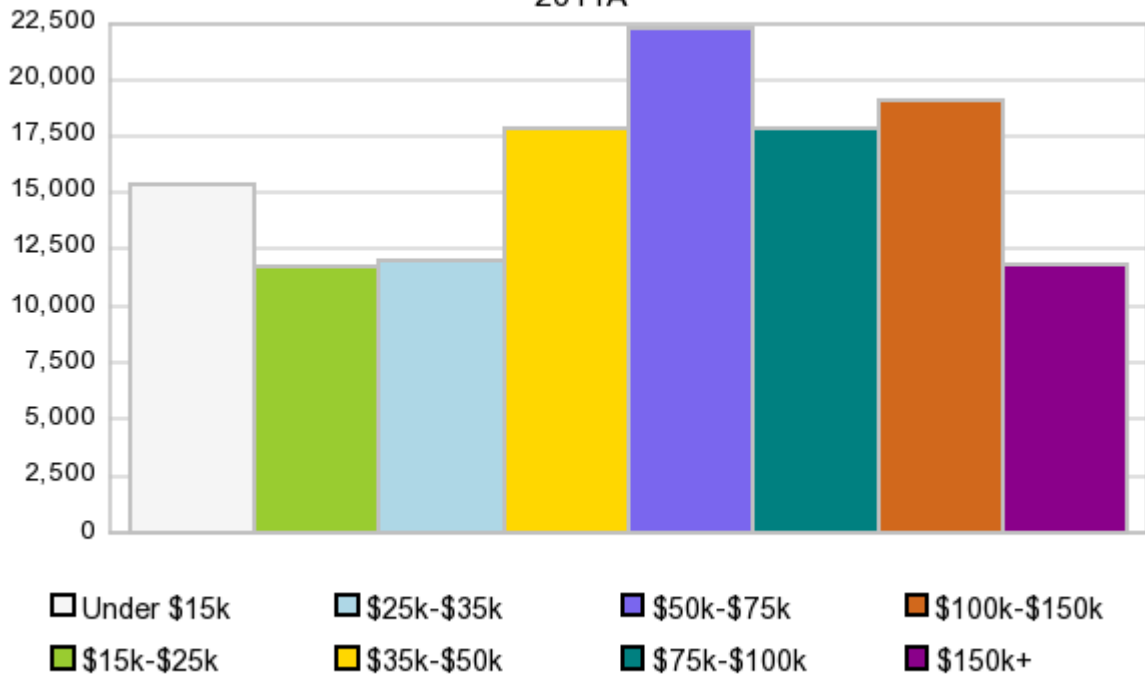
