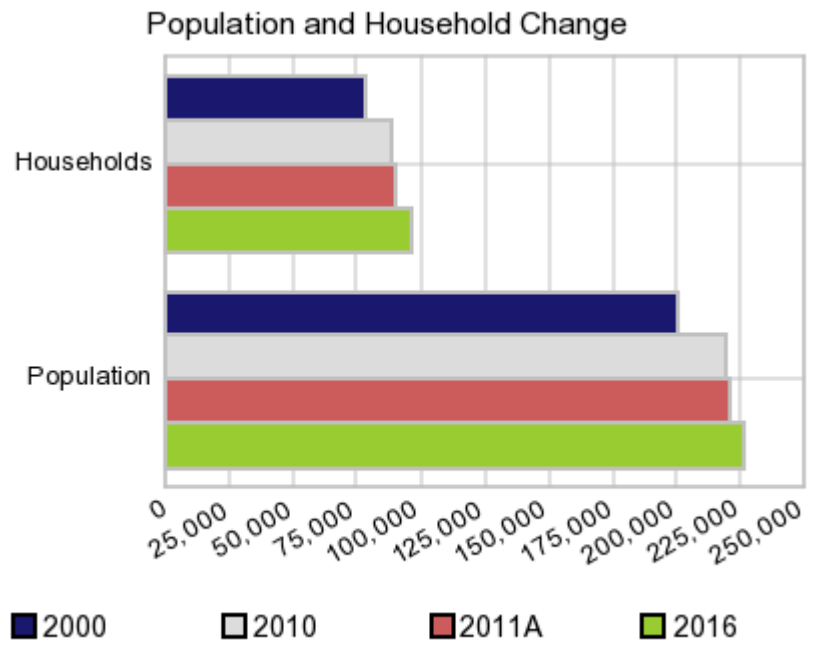

Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **78,165** and changed to **88,296** in 2010, representing a change of **13.0%**. The household count in 2011A was **89,916** and the household projection for 2016 is **96,344**, a change of **7.1%**.

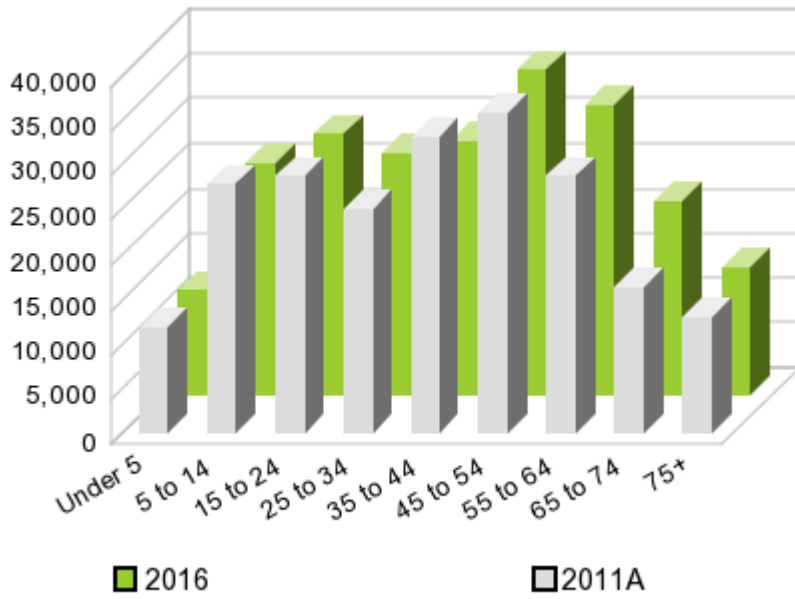
The population in the study area in 2000 was **200,635** and in 2010 it was **219,607**, roughly a **9.5%** change. The population in 2011A was **221,071** and the projection for 2016 is **226,689** representing a change of **2.5%**.

Age



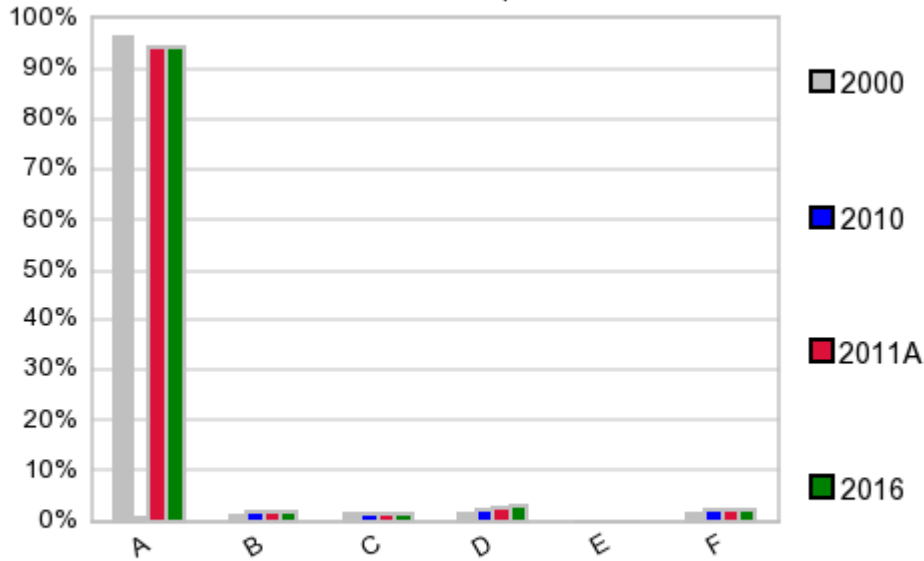
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33**, and in 2000, it was **37**. The median age in 2011A is **40** and it is predicted to change in five years to **42** years. In 2011A, females represented **50.6%** of the population with a median age of **41** and males represented **49.4%** of the population with a median age of **39** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

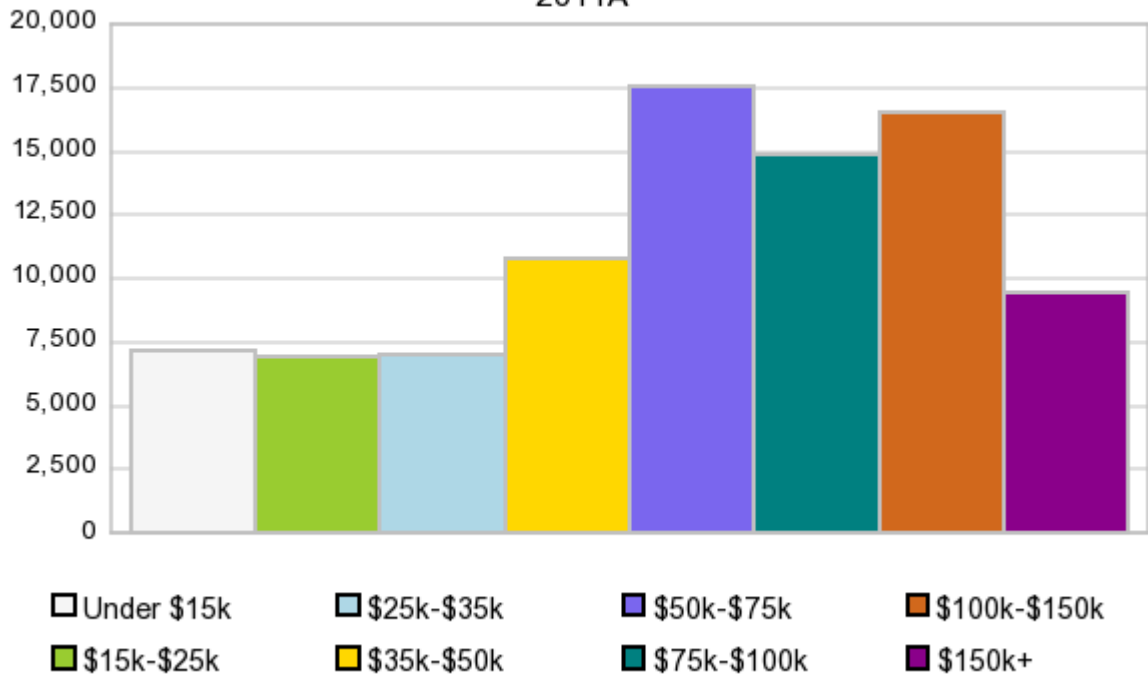
