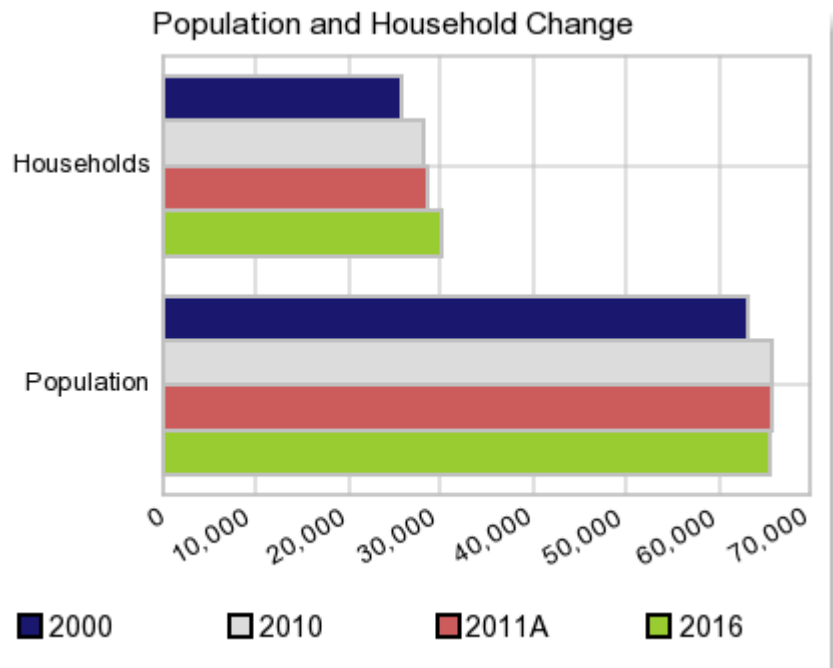

Population Demographics:

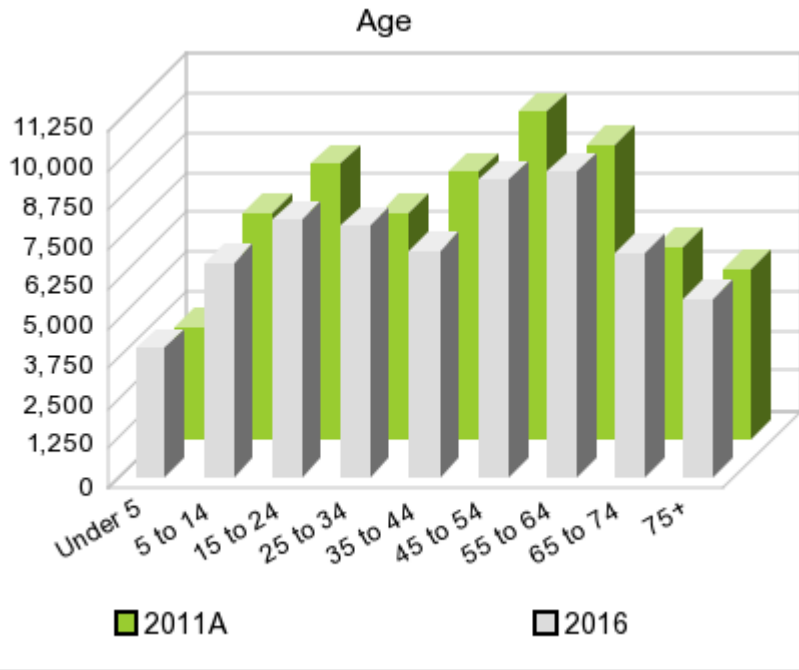
The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **25,726** and changed to **27,990** in 2010, representing a change of **8.8%**. The household count in 2011A was **28,408** and the household projection for 2016 is **30,075**, a change of **5.9%**.

The population in the study area in 2000 was **63,303** and in 2010 it was **65,707**, roughly a **3.8%** change. The population in 2011A was **65,690** and the projection for 2016 is **65,589** representing a change of **-0.2%**.

Population by Age



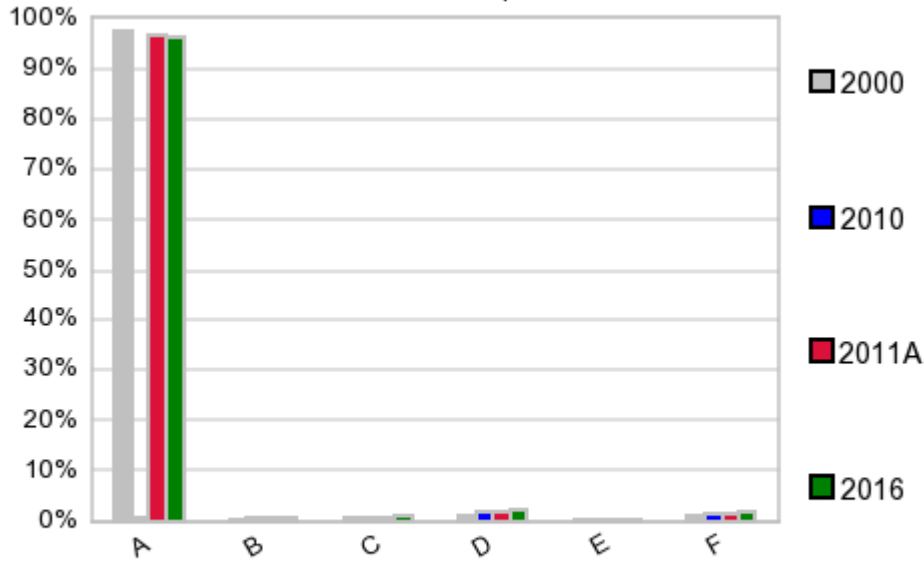
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **34**, and in 2000, it was **39**. The median age in 2011A is **43** and it is predicted to change in five years to **44** years. In 2011A, females represented **51.2%** of the population with a median age of **44** and males represented **48.8%** of the population with a median age of **41** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

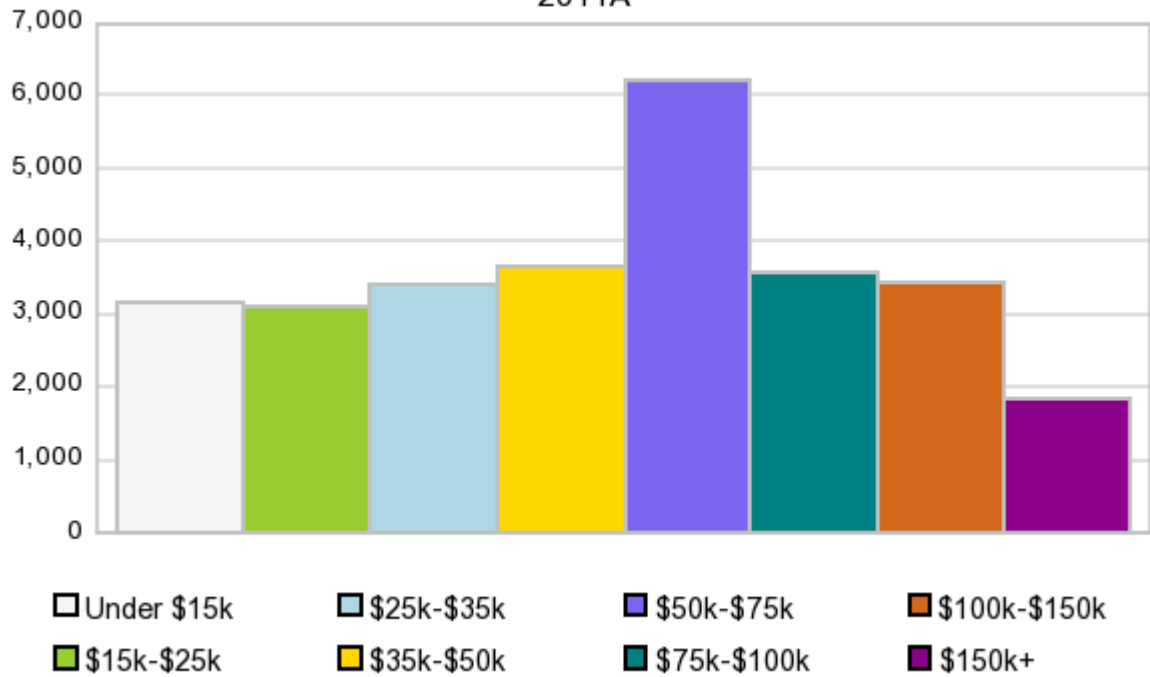
