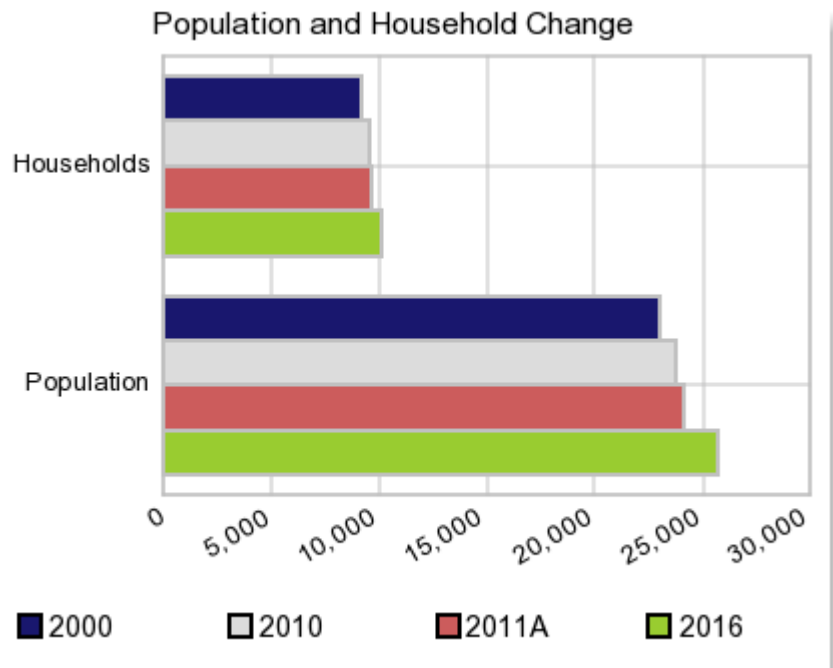

## Executive Summary Report with Charts

### Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **9,234** and changed to **9,557** in 2010, representing a change of **3.5%**. The household count in 2011A was **9,665** and the household projection for 2016 is **10,098**, a change of **4.5%**.

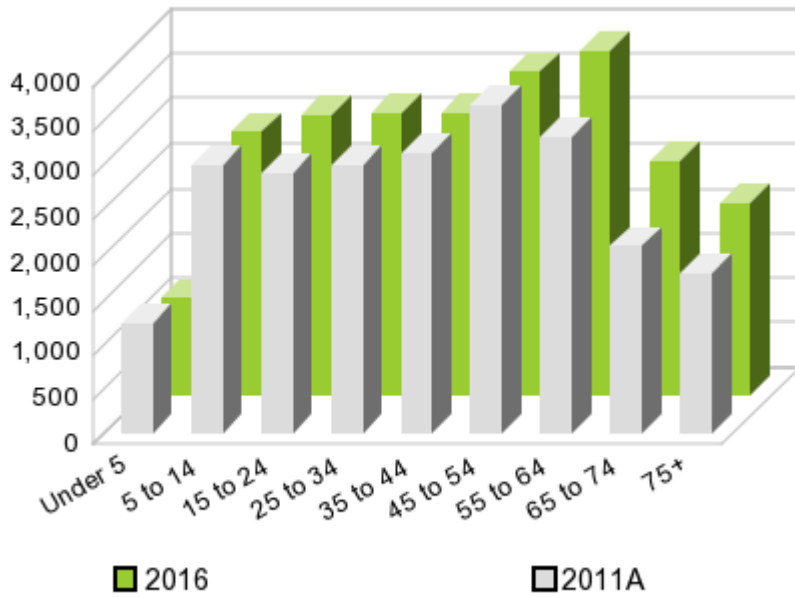
The population in the study area in 2000 was **23,072** and in 2010 it was **23,770**, roughly a **3.0%** change. The population in 2011A was **24,158** and the projection for 2016 is **25,702** representing a change of **6.4%**.

### Age



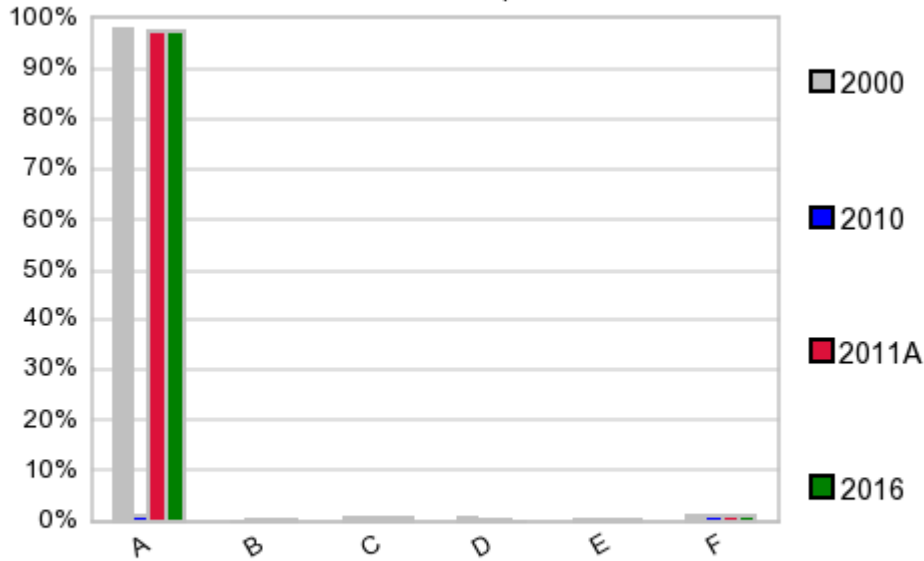
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **35**, and in 2000, it was **39**. The median age in 2011A is **41** and it is predicted to change in five years to **43** years. In 2011A, females represented **51.2%** of the population with a median age of **43** and males represented **48.9%** of the population with a median age of **40** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **Other**.

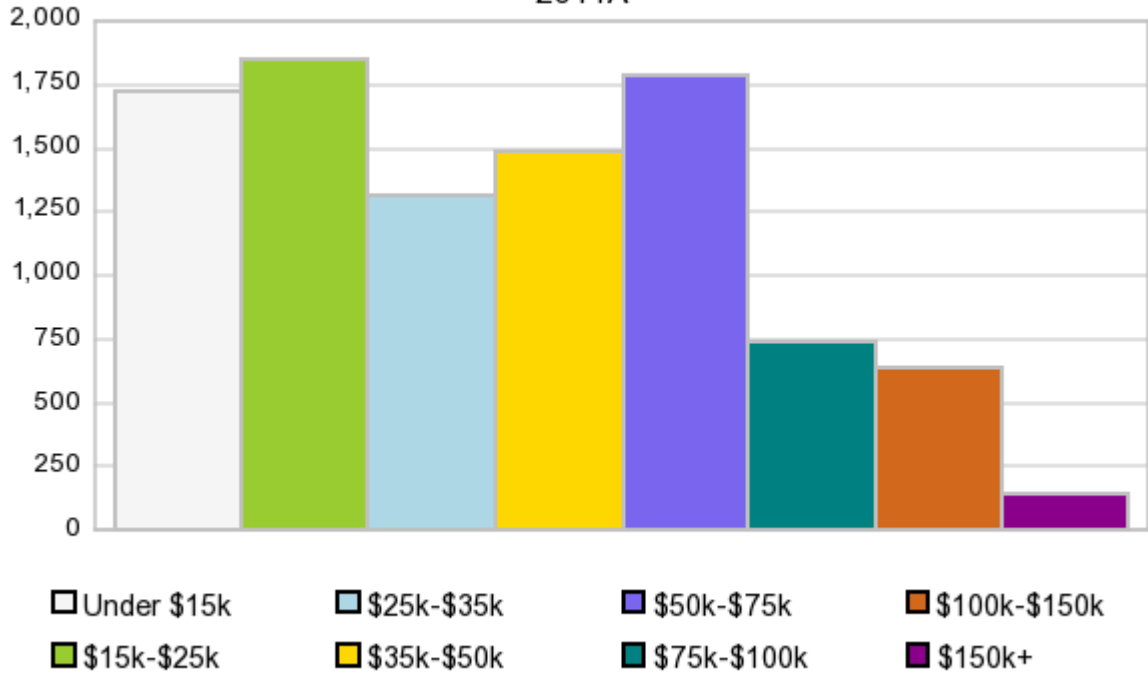
