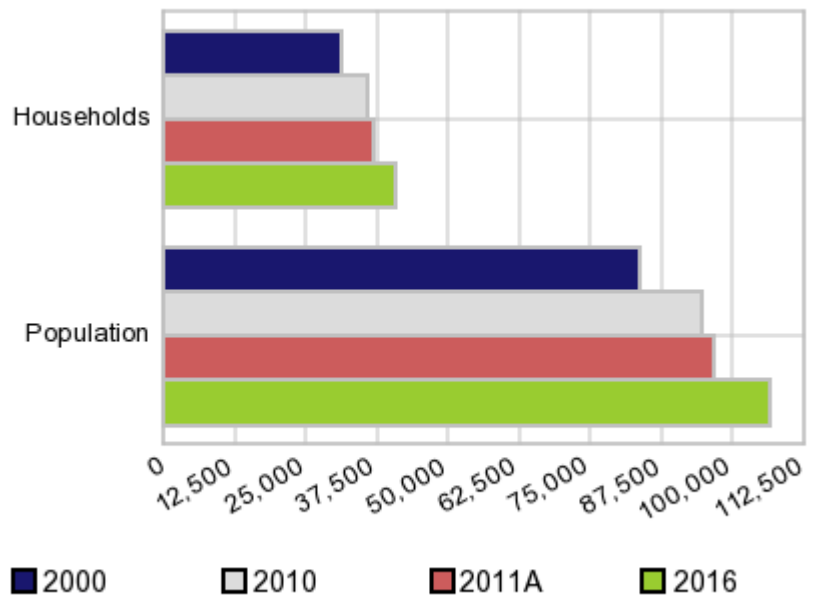
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **31,018** and changed to **35,767** in 2010, representing a change of **15.3%**. The household count in 2011A was **36,762** and the household projection for 2016 is **40,742**, a change of **10.8%**.

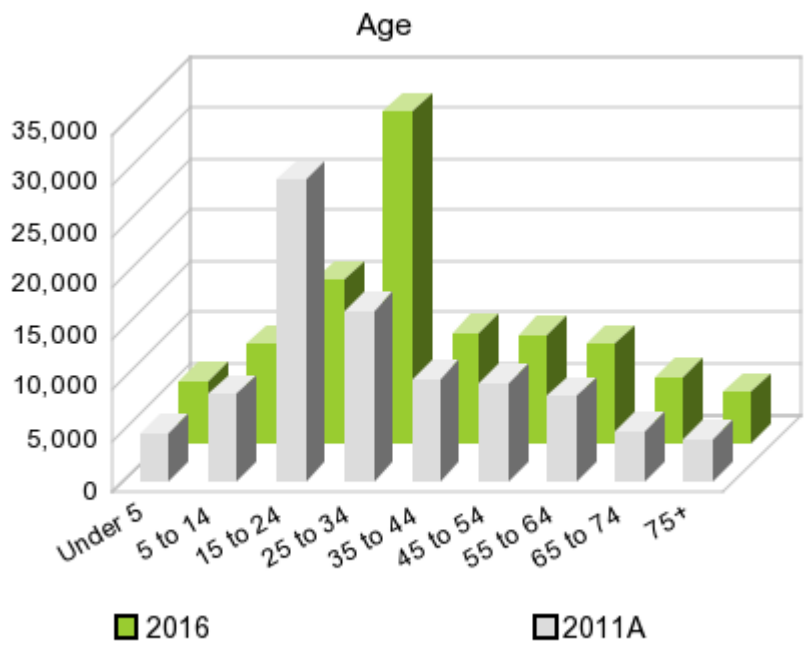
The population in the study area in 2000 was **83,681** and in 2010 it was **94,392**, roughly a **12.8%** change. The population in 2011A was **96,781** and the projection for 2016 is **106,284** representing a change of **9.8%**.

Population by Age



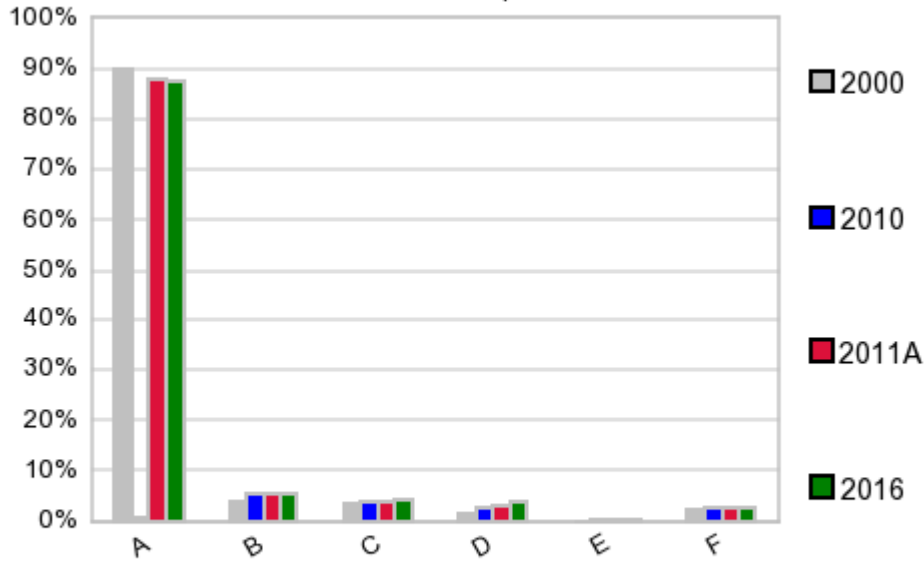
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **25**, and in 2000, it was **26**. The median age in 2011A is **27** and it is predicted to change in five years to **31** years. In 2011A, females represented **47.2%** of the population with a median age of **28** and males represented **52.8%** of the population with a median age of **26** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 18 to 24** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

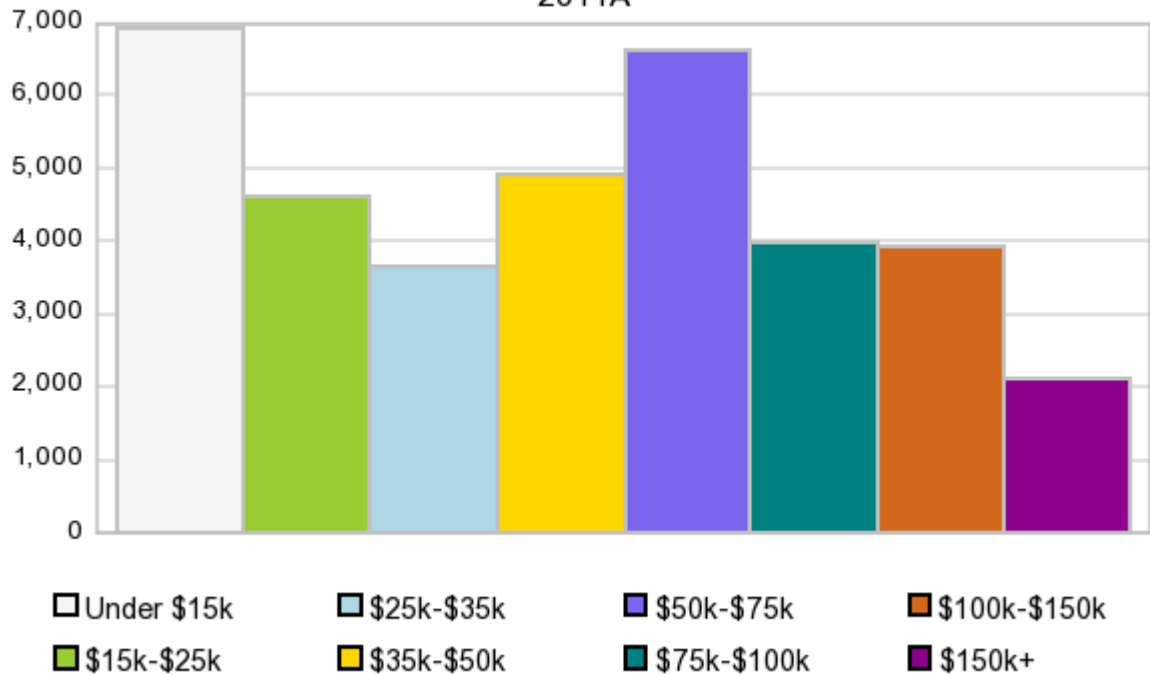
