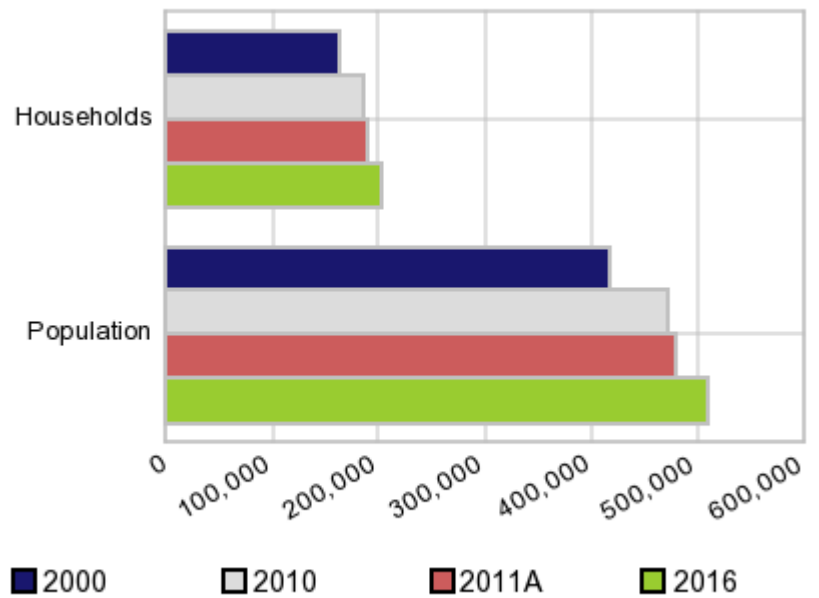
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **163,611** and changed to **187,167** in 2010, representing a change of **14.4%**. The household count in 2011A was **190,219** and the household projection for 2016 is **202,405**, a change of **6.4%**.

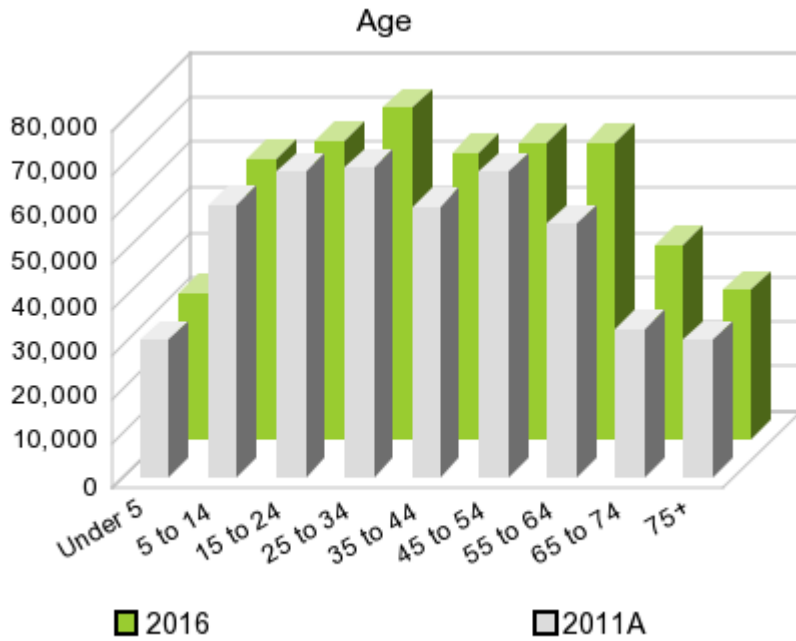
The population in the study area in 2000 was **417,939** and in 2010 it was **471,221**, roughly a **12.7%** change. The population in 2011A was **478,631** and the projection for 2016 is **508,237** representing a change of **6.2%**.

Population by Age



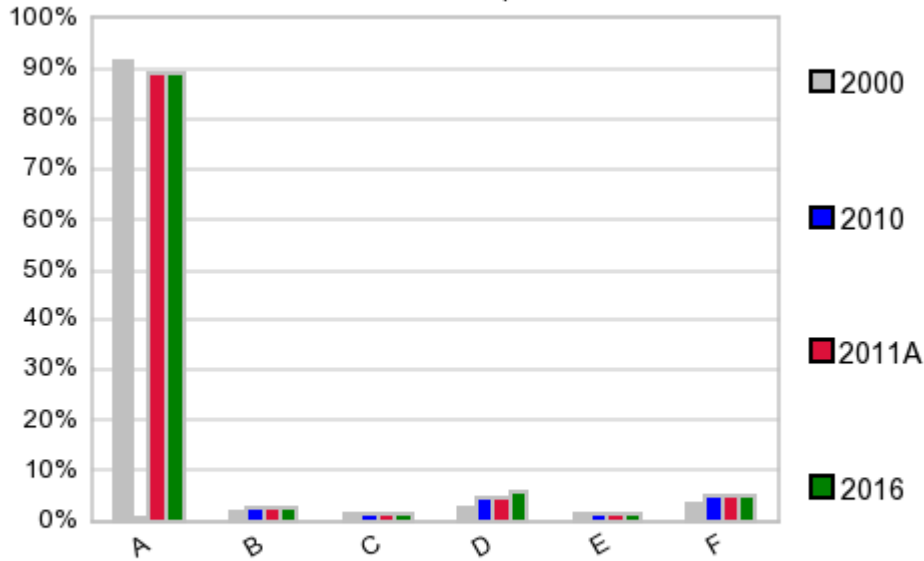
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33**, and in 2000, it was **35**. The median age in 2011A is **37** and it is predicted to change in five years to **38** years. In 2011A, females represented **50.8%** of the population with a median age of **38** and males represented **49.2%** of the population with a median age of **35** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 25 to 34** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **Other**.

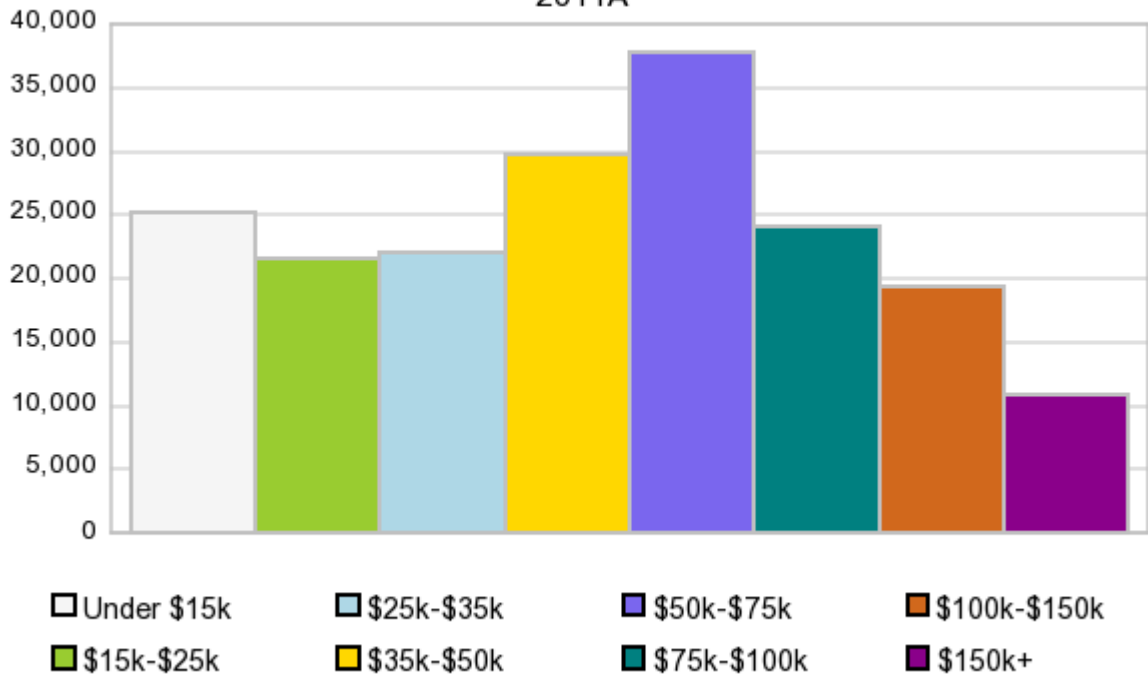
