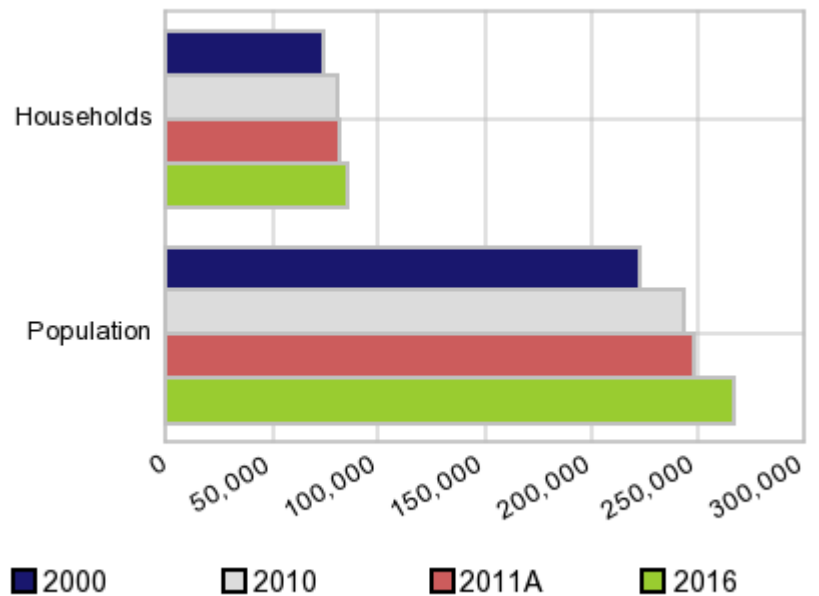
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **73,993** and changed to **80,592** in 2010, representing a change of **8.9%**. The household count in 2011A was **81,585** and the household projection for 2016 is **85,535**, a change of **4.8%**.

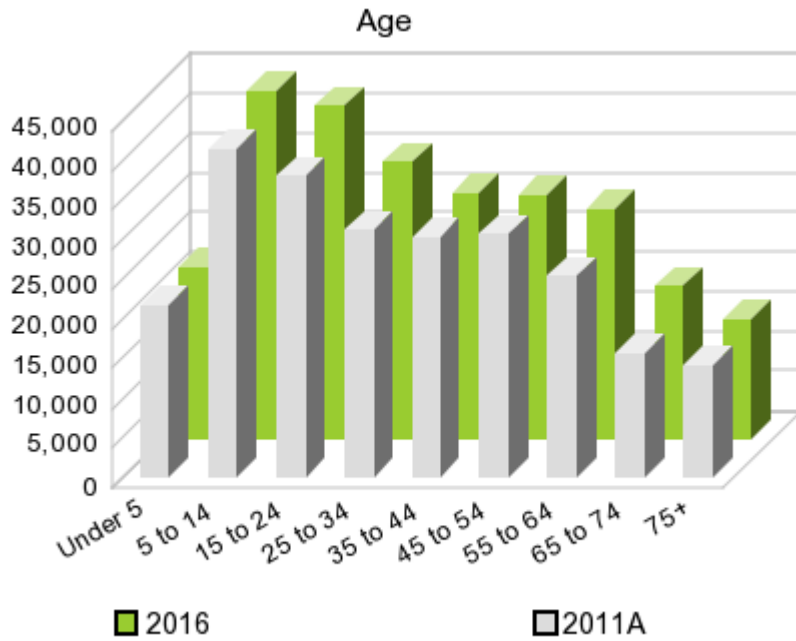
The population in the study area in 2000 was **222,581** and in 2010 it was **243,231**, roughly a **9.3%** change. The population in 2011A was **247,928** and the projection for 2016 is **266,701** representing a change of **7.6%**.

Population by Age



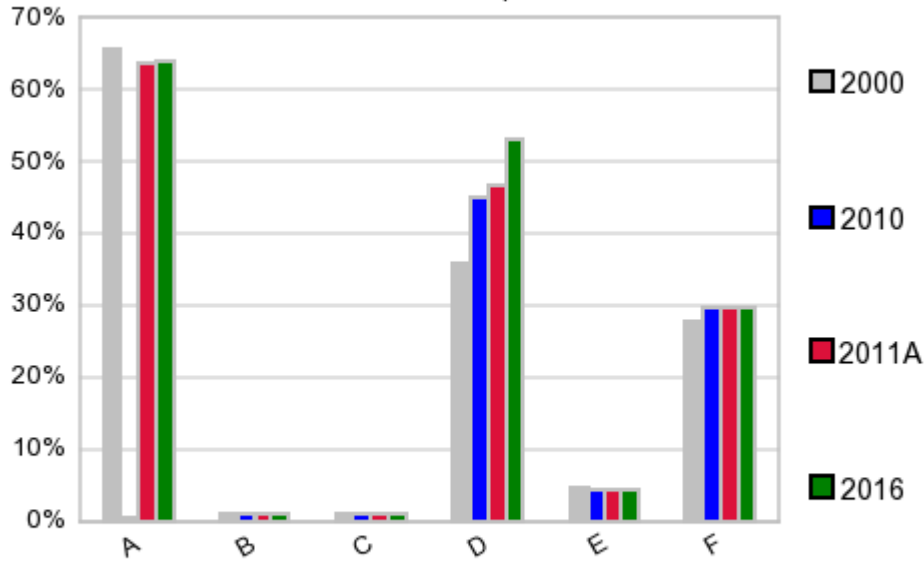
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32**, and in 2000, it was **31**. The median age in 2011A is **32** and it is predicted to change in five years to **32** years. In 2011A, females represented **50.0%** of the population with a median age of **33** and males represented **50.0%** of the population with a median age of **31** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 5 to 14** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.

In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **Black**.

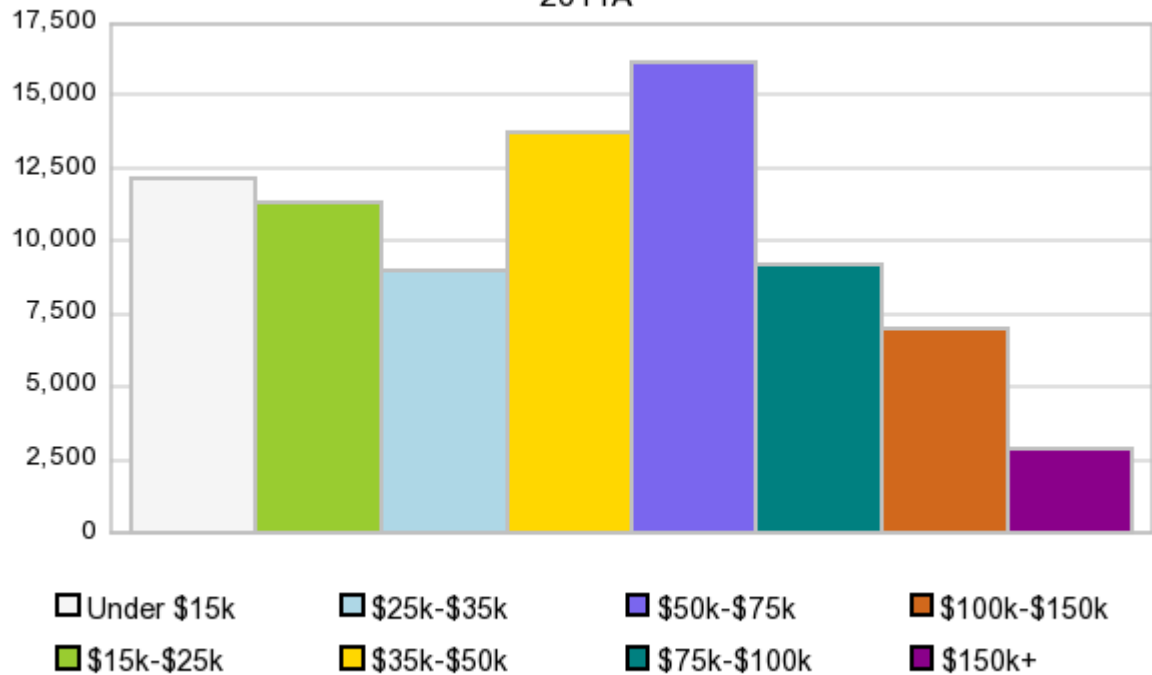
